

2008 Business Plan for the Regulatory Law Committee

- 1 To hold monthly meetings to discuss matters of interest, including:
 - (a) monitoring new cases within the field of regulatory law
 - (b) monitoring new legislation within the field of regulatory law
 - (c) monitoring new proposals for legislation within the field of regulatory law, including:
 - (i) responding to government consultations and proposals
 - (ii) responding to consultations and other proposals from other bodies, e.g. the Law Society
 - (iii) committee members attending meetings organised by stakeholders, where appropriate
 - (d) monitoring legal/business developments particularly relevant to the field of regulatory law
- 2 To report, via meeting minutes, on the above discussions and responses to CLLS Committee, where necessary
- 3 To liaise, where appropriate, with other specialist CLLS committees in relation to the above
- 4 Where appropriate, to be a spokesperson on the above issues, particularly in response to government consultations and proposals for legislation
- 5 Where necessary, to recruit additional members to ensure good representation from City firms practising regulatory law.
