HIGH COURT 2017

The next High Court selection exercise is due to launch at 13:00 on 12 January. There are up to 25 vacancies across all 3 divisions.

In past High Court selection exercises, successful candidates will normally have had previous sitting experience as a judge. For the first time across all 3 divisions, this competition is also open to those without such experience.

Also for the first time, there will be two application tracks for the recruitment of High Court judges. The first will be on similar lines to past JAC exercises, and the second is designed to take account of those who have gained experience at High Court level as a s9 judge.
